5 DAYS/ 4 NIGHTS

DAY 1

Welcome aboard as our **Integrity Travel Tour Director** helps us as we make our way south through the Land of Lincoln to our 1st overnight stop in **Paducah, Kentucky**. This afternoon finds us on a guided tour of the **Ryman Auditorium**, home to the Grand Ole Opry from 1943 to 1974. We return to the magnificent Opryland complex in the mid-afternoon before we freshen up for a great **dinner** and a live performance at the **Grand Ole Opry**. **(B,D)**

DAY 4

After **breakfast** we'll take a bit of time to enjoy our surroundings before checking out of our hotel and heading north. Our destination today is **Bardstown, Kentucky** where we'll visit **My Old Kentucky Home**. While in Bardstown we will also take the time to tour the **Heaven Hill Distillery** where we'll learn about the history of Kentucky Bourbon. Late afternoon finds us checking into our hotel in Bardstown and tonight we'll have a fabulous time as we enjoy dinner and entertainment at the **Old Stable Inn**. **(B,D)**
