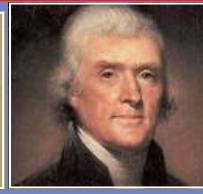
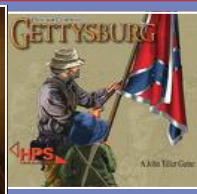

OCTOBER 8, 2010: FRIDAY

OCTOBER 12, 2010: TUESDAY

We have scheduled a tour of the **United States Naval Academy**, founded in 1845 and dedicated to accomplish its mission to develop midshipmen “**morally, mentally and physically**”. Mid-afternoon finds us back in **Colonial Williamsburg** where we have the chance to visit the Colonial Capital, the Governor's Palace, Bassett Hall, the Courthouse and much, much more. We've included **dinner** this evening at the **King's Arm Tavern** in Colonial Williamsburg plus some extra time to explore. (B,D)

OCTOBER 14, 2010: THURSDAY

Breakfast starts our day before we head west to the home of **Thomas Jefferson - Monticello**—here we will see the home of our 3rd President. Our travels then take us through the **Allegheny Mountains** of West Virginia on into Ohio for our overnight stop; along the way we'll enjoy a tasty **dinner** together. (B,D)

OCTOBER 15, 2010: FRIDAY

After **breakfast** and check out this morning we head into the heart to Dayton for a visit the **National Museum of the United States Air Force**.
